Over a year ago, *Asau Baptist Church* here on the island of Savaii began supporting missionaries Peneueta and Robyn Faafouina who are planting *Lighthouse Baptist Church* on the neighboring island of Upolu. It has been our conviction that even though we are a very young church plant ourselves, we must be missions-minded from the outset if we are to be a true New Testament local church. Praise God for a teachable and tender-hearted congregation here in Asau who embraced the Great Commission and mandate for world-wide missions.

Earlier this year, Pastor Faafouina and *Lighthouse Baptist Church* purchased their own land and began building their first church house.
