We are grateful for your continued faithfulness to support us with your prayers and finances. These are difficult days for many people and His continued goodness to us through you is a great encouragement to us. We never take this for granted.

This summer, our hearts have been saddened by a couple of tragic accidents that took two of our young friends. One young man was thirty-three with a wife and four children. The other man was only twenty-eight and leaves a wife and two children. Both men loved the Lord and served Him in their churches. Please pray for these families.

The latest news on our efforts to reach out to Muslims in Jacksonville has been encouraging to us. We have become friends with a Baptist pastor from Syria who is new in the USA and wants to start a ministry with Arabic speaking people in Jacksonville. We have found a church that will allow him to use their property to get started and also found him and his wife an English teacher (not me). He has been looking for a job to support his family and we need your prayers for this need. Please understand that this ministry is in the infant stages and we have a long way to go. It is good to see some progress.

This month, we have wept with those that are weeping and now we are getting ready to return to Seattle for the wedding of our second grandson, Joshua. So we get to rejoice with those who rejoice and life continues on with a sense of balance. Isn't God good to give us some good things as we encounter the difficulties of life?
