We have a family in church that has been building a small house for many years and now it is coming close to completion. It has a kitchen/dinning room and living room in one room. It will take around \$2,000.00 to build and furnish it with a commode, lavatory and shower. They have NOT asked for any help. They are poor but very proud. If the Lord would speak to you to help the **Quijano** (kee-hà-no) family, it would be such a tremendous blessing to them. They have NEVER had inside facilities!



We are looking at September 2013 to start our furlough. Our desire is to visit our supporters and try to re-gain lost support while on furlough but at the same time, we desire to make our furlough as short as possible because we want to be in Mexico where God has placed us to labor for Him. We look forward to a bit of rest and having fellowship with God's people.
