We are starting to hear from people that they are hearing the music we are airing and our tests. It's exciting to be so close to full-time programming after all of the preparations, permits, and training. We plan to begin recording and airing our services and doing other regular programming starting in April as we are waiting for our shipment to arrive with all of the necessary equipment.

4. Please pray for Brothers Philip Smith, Rocky Brooks, and Stephen Taylor.

These three men are preparing for their missions trip through the BIML CLAIM program to Asau in two weeks. Pray for the Lord to provide for all of their needs and safe travels. Please also pray for our building project that the Lord would keep everyone safe and provide for all that is needed.
