I had a transmission go out in one of our Mexican vehicles. It cost \$1,332.00 to re-build, of which I received \$650.00 toward the re-build. At times it gets somewhat stressful, it sorta checks out my faith/trust in the Lord Jesus. The Lord is always faithful, no question about that! It's this guy (**me**) that needs to exercise more faith in HIM!

Even with the difficulties and problems, it is a blessed privilege to be allowed to serve our wonderful Lord and Savior Jesus Christ. And after all is said and done, we get to spend eternity with Him. What more could we ask for?
