Three men and a young fellow are coming down the first part of May from NC. We are going to try to complete two projects before they leave. I'm to the point in life that it has become a bit more difficult for me to roll around under vehicles, so I want to dig a mechanic's pit to drive vehicles over and that way I can stand underneath them and work on them. The other is to build a shelter for our church bus. I figure the metal roofing for the shelter for the bus, concrete and steel needed for the mechanic's pit will cost us \$2,000.00+. One of the men coming has given \$500.00, so we are short \$1,500.00. If anyone would like to help in these two projects, it will be very much appreciated.
