My stateside travels began with a missions conference in New Jersey at one of our supporting churches. What a season of refreshing as I visited people who have become dear friends over the years! On one day of the conference, I even enjoyed a good game of Scrabble with the pastor's wife and one of the other missionaries. From New Jersey, I went to all new churches in Pennsylvania, New Hampshire, Vermont, and Maine. At one point, while riding through the mountains of New Hampshire, I saw white birches lining both sides of the road as far as the eye could see. Against the backdrop of an overcast sky, they were breathtakingly beautiful! In almost every case last month, I was hosted at the pastors' homes
