Back to the old days of sleeping outside in hammocks or it is mosquito feeding time again! Very minor compared to the sufferings of our brothers and sisters in Christ in other places!

Thank you for your continued prayer on behalf of Simon's daughter getting her BABC (born abroad birth certificate). No good news as yet. Also thank you for your continued prayer for our oldest son (Tony). He still has his foot and leg, thus far, but having a \difficult time getting infection under control.



Papi Juan (Tim's father-in-law) went home to be with the Lord Dec. 29, 2018. He was also my friend. I/we knew him before he accepted the Lord Jesus and I saw him grow in the Lord and in the Word over the years. He was very faithful in his walk with the Lord and touched many lives. "So then faith cometh by hearing, and hearing by the word of God". Mama Esthela (Papi Juan's wife) is having a very

difficult time adjusting. Not like the states in getting social security. If family does not take care of her, she will be in a desperate struggle to survive. In most cases, family members are the providers and care takers in these situations in Mexico, NOT government.
