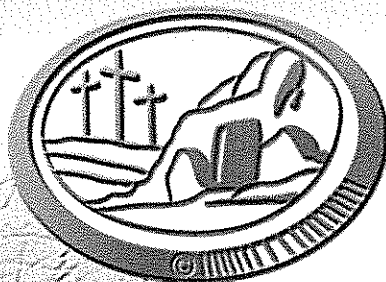

As I observed, others were having difficulty in answering the lessons because lack of Tagalog Bible nearest to KJV version. It is a good thing there is one lady who have a Tagalog Bible. Sad to say, we don't have anymore a Bible in the office for the inmates. It is a great blessing to hear that others are thankful that they were brought inside the jail to know God. They confessed they always keep on rejecting God while they are still living outside the jail. Sis. Nanet said, "One faithful PBI student many years is sharing God's Word to her fellow inmates". Well, that's just why we're there; to get the word into their hands and by God's grace into their heart.

On June 30<sup>th</sup> a container full of Bibles left the docks, thanks to the combined efforts of the International Team and Bearing Precious Seed. *Unfortunately the Tagalog Bible had an error so they had to stop the printing to correct it and it wasn't ready in time for the shipment. I'll need to buy some Tagalog Bibles for the inmates in Manila and would appreciate your prayers about the finances.
