

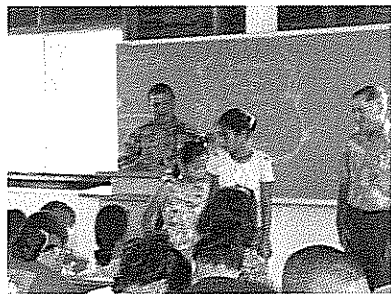
## DANNY AND DARLEEN WHETSTONE

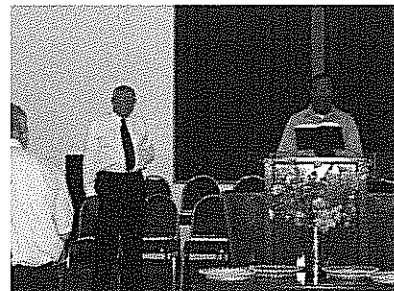
furlough during our visit, but we had the opportunity to spend some time with Paul and Bob.
