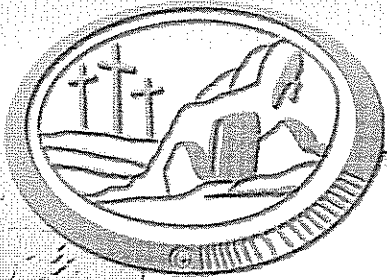

This year in the prisons alone there have been 994 souls that have made a profession of faith in our Lord Jesus Christ. The Prisoner Bible Institute has 1643 inmates studying the Bible. Our Filipino missionary Bro. JoJo Daa is sold out to the Lord and has opened up two new prisons in the last three months. **'Oh that men would praise the LORD for his goodness, and for his wonderful works to the children of men!'**

Three of our four families, are making the final preparations to move to the Philippines, with one single lady, Susan Willis, just beginning her deputation for the Philippines. The Childress Family will be moving in the fall of this next year.

The paperwork has been sent to the Philippine Embassy in Washington, DC for their Red Ribbon approval on their documents. This is an essential immigration process in the Philippines for a 9G Visa. Well, Praise the Lord everything was submitted and the Wonser Family just received back their approved documents. Now, we're waiting on the Red Ribbon approval for the Ellis Family and the Adams Family; please keep praying. These three families will be departing the USA on March 1, 2011.

Thank you for another faithful year of prayer and support for Diane and Me. It's because of you and the good hand of the Lord that the labor in the Philippines marches on. Our thought for this next year is: **More souls for Heaven in 2011!**
