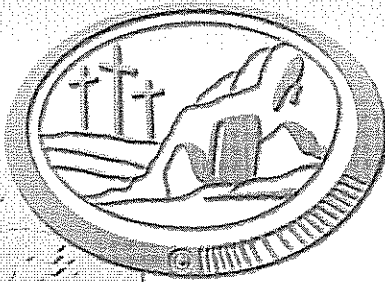

I haven't reported on the Prisoners Bible Institute for quite a while, but the enrollment and lessons are doing quite well. Just like in the states the inmates are moved from one location to another, but our volunteers and national missionaries are doing a great job in keeping up with their new location and helping them to continue studying God's Word.



Our count for enrollment as of April 2011 was 1689 students. My good friend Doug Sisson who pastors Mt. Calvary Baptist Church in General Santos, Mindanao has started taking the lessons into three prisons. We are so excited to see the PBI expand

into this new area of Mindanao. Please pray for those who are beginning the study of the Bible.

The Rock of Ages Chapel in Bilibid Prison, Anniversary service was packed with those who faithfully attend each week and scores of new visitors. There were two preaching services and thirteen souls came forward and trusted Jesus Christ as Lord and Savior.

Bethany Baptist Church has started another chapel partnering with us in another section of Bilibid Prison and is growing in attendance each week. The church is waiting on approval from the Bureau of Jail Management to build a structure that's more permanent for worship. Would you help us pray this gets approved soon?

Our three couple's have settled into life in the Philippines and have begun language studies. The Adams family is living in the Makati area which is a suburb of Metro Manila, their having a private tutor help them learn the Tagalog language. The Wonser family and the Ellis family have moved to Cebu, where their studying the Cebuano language. Please pray for all these families as they adjust to their new culture.
