Dear Friends and Supporters,

Since our last letter so much has happened and things are still moving in a rapid pace and sometimes it is rather tough to keep up with it all! The first phase of the Paraguay Training has been completed and Bro. David Wise is in Paraguay now to move into the 2nd phase. Only eternity will reveal the wonder of this training! We have had to do some adjusting, but over all it has been good. Because of this training we now have Beacon Baptist Mission of Paraguay and very probably within the next few weeks, Florentino Britez, the national pastor, will become an intricate part of the Beacon International Baptist Mission family.

We had hoped for a "Suit Case Radio" Station to come with our registration and "PJ", but the government shot that down quickly; however, on the heels of the defeat, came great success. Bro. Britez is now being invited to preach on some major radio stations which expands the gospel all over Paraguay, and several other neighboring countries. Our vision was a 25-30 mile radius, but God's was all of Paraguay, plus neighboring countries. A survey is being done to see just how major an outreach this is producing. This is a blessing also in the fact that we have no upkeep of equipment or building maintenance. Florentino just records his messages and either takes them, or sends them to the radio station and over the air they go! Oh, the power of the Word of God! I am excited, to say the least, and now to watch God bring glory and honor and praise to His Holy Name!

I just received a call a few days ago about the need to recruit three 2 family teams to go into the mountains of Guatemala. The great need is to reach some Indian tribes with the gospel that are presently unreached. Bro. Paul Morrow has been there for some 15 years and is established, therefore, all that is needed is for someone to say, "Here am I, send me!" I don't know about you, but that excites me beyond words! Are you interested? Age a problem? Only to you! Just let God take control and then hang on! Amen and Amen!

In review, we had a very good 15th Anniversary meeting in July and many of our missionary families were able to attend and be a part of the celebration. Pastor Jason Wiley and Pastor Allen Johnson both preached great messages to a full house at The Answer Baptist Church on Tuesday and Wednesday nights. Folk were blest and challenged to do a little more and keep going in these latter days! We were able to speak to missionaries in Romania and Macedonia, which was a treat for us all. A short history of BIBM was shared, to allow each missionary to see what God has done in the past 15 years. Oh how good God is to His children!

Thanks for you help and please pray for us and the many doors that are opening to BIBM. Pray for our health, funds to not only start the work, but to keep it going once started, and for new churches to be planted all over the Southeast!
