## New Preaching Points

We have written a few times about one of our preaching points called Acwa Ranch. They are doing very well. Their leader is a man called Oto, who has proven to be faithful. He is actively reaching the lost and discipling the new believers in Acwa Ranch. He is currently in our Bible School.

Another man, Patrick, is also from the Acwa Ranch preaching point. Patrick has felt God leading him to be more involved in reaching his people, so Patrick has been helping me during the week as we go to various preaching points. He has also been instrumental in starting three other discipleship groups in other villages. We are praying that these discipleship groups will become preaching points, and eventually churches.

Men like these are the reason God brought us over to Uganda. Please pray that God continues to give us more faithful men.

## Old Church Tent

Four years ago we were able to buy a new tent for our church in Gulu to meet in. Well, the tent finally died a few weeks ago. Another terrible wind and rain storm completely shredded the canvas on the roof. We are now using the grass thatch shelter that was being used by the children's church for our Sunday services.

We knew that the tent was on its last leg, but we were hoping for it to hold out until we were able to put on the roof of our permanent church building. We are still

trying to raise the funds needed to do that. We need \$15,000 to build the roof, and we currently have around \$11,000 in the roof fund. Once we get the roof on, we will be able to begin using the building immediately even without the doors and windows.

## **New PO Box**

We now have a new post office box in Gulu. Evidently someone has been tampering with our mail off and on over the last couple of years. Our old PO Box is easily accessible to the general public. You can easily enter inside the post office and have access to the 'open end' of our old box. This new number makes that a little more difficult.

Also, please be aware of any money scams that might come your way. One of our supporting churches has already received a letter asking the church to send the support directly to our PO box. Thankfully, the pastor called BIMI and confirmed that the letter was a scam. Our policy has always been to send support to BIMI only.
