Dear Supporting Friends,

I just talked to the only missionary in Serbia and my heart burned to be back in the Eastern European Countries! As we talked I realized nothing has changed and the same ole Devil is still trying to stop and side-track every bit of ministry in that part of the world. HOWEVER, he is failing because God has called this young man to go and he is not going to give up! I gathered up all that I had to send him as far as literature, a translation of the Gospel of John and some discipleship material. He has a big advantage over most American Missionaries, his mother is Serbian and that gives him dual citizenship as well as his children! What a blessing! His name is Danny Foss and let me encourage you to pray for him as he will be heading back to Belgrade in April.

Christine and I have had a whirlwind beginning of this year! Christine's heart beat slowed to 40 and off to the emergency room we went. We did not think much about it but once there and the nurses and doctors began to do things "STAT!" we figured out quickly that it was serious. She had to have a pacemaker put in and while doing that, she quit breathing and her lungs began to collapse. After that was straightened out, her blood oxygen was low and would not come up. Finally, after 4 days in ICU things began to turn around and she got to come home. Our daughter, Angie, came up from Florida and stayed with us for 10 days and helped us tremendously. Christine is doing fine now and I am going strong. It will take her another few days to get back to speed, but God sure has shown His might and power during all this adventure! Thanks for all of your prayers!

As you read this letter Bro. David Wise and his wife Mary Helen are in Honduras doing a training school for our missionary Yery Martinez and his people. This is our first class in Honduras and our prayer is that it will be a great blessing and asset to Bro. Martinez and his church there. We still do not have our foundation approved there, and we are still waiting on the good ole government....sounds sort of like our mess in Washington! Just help us pray for God's intervention and approval of this important document from the government. A lot is riding on this foundation.

The radio work in Paraguay is really taking off! Bro. Britez has his hands full keeping up with folk that are getting saved through this radio ministry. We are paying for 3 large stations and then there are 4 or 5 smaller stations running his messages for free. We estimate the gospel is reaching at least 2 million people. We hope to go down there later in the year and help a church ordain him. He needs the credentials to carry on his work and ministry there. He still needs funds to finance these broadcasts. If anyone would like to help, \$25 to \$50 a month would really help. Just send your donations to the BIBM Office marked "Paraguay Radio Ministry" and we will get it right to him. This is money that will be invested in souls immediately!

Christine and I want to thank you for all you prayers and support! God has been so good to us and we appreciate each of you for your love, concern and help!
