We're on the field! We arrived in Japan on Thursday, June 19 and hit the ground running! I stood behind the pulpit and preached that following Sunday morning.



I was praying that our first Sunday would be special. Glory to God, **two men from Yokohama responded to the gospel message and trusted Christ as their personal Savior!** That was so comforting and exciting and special to me as a missionary!

As I sit here and write this prayer letter, I am deeply thankful for your faithful prayers and support that make this possible. 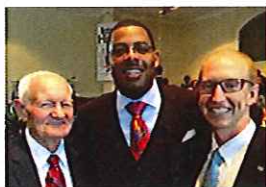

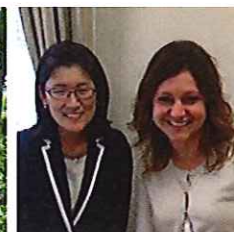
