Costel, a young man in his early 20s (not the Costel who works for the church), has attended a few times over the past few months. Please pray he will come faithfully, and that he will understand his need of salvation.

Bob had his hernia repair surgery. There were no complications, and he is doing fine.

We mentioned in our last prayer letter that Bob made a six-week trip to the States for a mini-furlough. He also went to deal with some family issues regarding his mother. She is 84 and suffers from severe dementia. His family is taking financial advantage of her, and her needs are not being met. Bob hired a lawyer and petitioned the court to be his mother's legal guardian. The court hearing is January 7 at 10 a.m. Bob will be flying back to the states on New Year's Eve. Please pray for traveling mercies as he flies back and that Bob will be appointed his mother's legal guardian.

Marianne will be staying in Romania to continue with the ministry. She will be assisted by Costel and Lenuta during Bob's absence. Costel, the man who works for the church, will be doing the messages while Bob is away. Please pray for Marianne as wintertime in Romania can be harsh.
