We spent a few minutes talking with a soldier about some of his office affairs, and when the opportunity presented itself I asked him, "Sergeant, if you died tonight, do you know where you would spend eternity?" He replied, "Well, I was brought up in the Catholic church and have tried to be good ever since then and I do good things to help out poor people... and so I think the good things I've done in my life will get me into heaven." The three of them meet on Sunday afternoons and take their time learning the fundamentals of the faith.

In February we had two military families, who just arrived to their new assignments at Yokota Air Base, to join the church. It's a privilege to provide a local New Testament church where these families can serve while they are stationed at Yokota.

Finally, we have the opportunity to buy the land and building we are currently renting. This is a big deal as the church has been renting for the last 40 years (and still doesn't own a thing!). If we could own this land then we would never have to worry about forfeiting the property in the case of the landlord's death or a change in location and, owning this property would eventually allow us to ease the heavy financial burden of renting in Tokyo. Please pray for us as this is a delicate decision. "Not that we are sufficient of ourselves to think any thing as of ourselves; but our sufficiency is of God" II Cor. 3:5.
