Dear Praying Pastors, Friends and Family,

Since arriving back to Romania in January our faith has been tried and continues to do so as we work through the tangled web of bureaucracy to get all the needed permits for Tina's House to be operational. So in all this James 1:3 says, "Knowing this, that the trying of your faith worketh patience." A year ago after starting the licensing process to have the girls come, the fire laws changed (because of the night club fires in Bucharest 2 years ago) and they said the home had to be rezoned from residential to a public building and pass all the new fire laws which has become an enormous task and expense. So, we are at a stand still and can not open the doors to start receiving any mothers and babies into the home until all the new requirements are met.

PRAISES - 1) Our first and "biggest" concern upon returning to Romania was getting the home to pass the fire retardant protection code. We praise the Lord for bringing in all \$8,000 for the funds needed to complete this procedure, and we also received the final certificate from Bucharest. 2) We praise the Lord for bringing on board a part-time house keeper. We've known Mariana for years and she is doing a great job of keeping Tina's House clean and smelling fresh. She is also a great team player willing to help with whatever we ask of her.

Now our next hurtle is a water supply source, the well we have now was tested and can't be used for human consumption in the home. So we have started the process for approval from the water company and the mayor's office to hook up to the main village water line a 1/4 mile away and at our expense. Then we have the fire hydrant problem. Local governments do not provide fire hydrant infrastructure, so the responsibility falls on us to have our own. We are required to have 2 *fire hydrants, 2 high pressure pumps, large backup generator, 15,000 gallon underground storage tank.* We have a concrete cistern left from the communist days, that we are hoping to use. In addition we need *detailed electrical, plumbing & heating drawings, digital fire alarm & surveillance systems, a metal fire escape, fire extinguishers, evacuation plans, exit lighting, and a larger main power line.* Please pray things will move forward quickly with permits & quotes and that the Lord will bring in the needed. If you would like to help with any amount (\$10-\$100) it would be such a blessing and an answer to prayer.

We know it will take thousands of dollars and more time, but we are determined to complete what the Lord called use to do. We believe the impact that this new home will have on the lives of theses unwed mothers their babies will far out weigh all these trials and expenses. Thank you for your prayers!
