We also had the joy of serving in Daniel and Maureen's wedding, two precious folks who truly love the Lord and have been a stedfast example to the new converts at church. Bro. Daniel is Scottish and has ran over 90 marathons!

It all began with an unexpected phone call on a Saturday morning. When the caller identified himself as a member of Parliament who wanted to secure some Bibles for his constituency we were overjoyed. We had the honor to meet with him and he shared his burden to provide the Word of God to the 40,000 people who live in his district, where many of the villages are considered remote and underdeveloped. A week ago we delivered 500 whole Bibles for distribution to the chiefs and village elders in those communities. Some "pastors" actually lead churches and do not have a Bible. God has opened a door for an unprecedented opportunity to reach into these areas with the Word of God. It was determined that the New Testaments with a presentation of the Gospel and a 20 lesson discipleship course built in would be better for the 40k people and a church in Washington state has pledged to provide a container with 60,000 New Testaments and 10,000 whole Bibles if we pay for the shipping. We're in the process of determining what the cost will be and then will set out to raise the funds. We will tour each town and village to distribute the Scriptures and will have many opportunities to preach the Gospel publically. Please pray to Thank the Lord for such a wonderful opportunity. We have seen God do the miraculous time and again from the outset of this ministry and are eager to see the Lord do it again for this project.
