We have asked you to pray about so many things and the constant flow of emails has been incredibly encouraging. In coming days I'll share the opportunities God has given us to focus on in the year ahead. Perhaps the greatest burden of my heart is the need for co-laborers. We are now in a position to help other missionaries to come and work here in Botswana. Please pray that God will call and that those whom He calls will answer the call to come and join in these harvest fields. They truly are white unto harvest but seasons bring change and change is quickly coming to Botswana and throughout Africa.
