My name is Corazon Tan, 54 years old. When I was still outside this facility, I already knew God but not as my Personal Lord and Savior. I know my life was a mess when I started using and selling drugs but in my mind I was doing it so that I could feed and send my children to school. But my life took a twisted turn when my husband and I were caught by the police. I was scared not for myself but for my kids. Who will take good care of my kids? That was the first question in my mind, but I can't do nothing because I'm inside the cell. It took me days to stop crying thinking that I will never see my kids again. When I was brought in Handumanan, usually the new inmate can't go outside the cell for a month except during Bible Study. We were not obliged to join any Bible Study. So I just stayed inside my cell and worrying about my children. But I realized even if I worry all the time about my kids, I can't do nothing so what I did I started to attend a Bible Study. Week after week I learned about the Word of God. And the best thing that happened to me is that I received Jesus as my Personal Lord and Savior. I have learned that being inside this facility for six years is to put my faith and trust in Jesus, that even though I am here, Jesus will take good care of my children through my parents. I know I am not a good daughter but I thanked the Lord that with all my mistakes I have done to my parents but still they forgave me and offered to take care of my kids while my husband and I are still incarcerated. That's one of the biggest blessing I received when I learn to put my faith in God. My husband is in District Jail and I am so happy that he is also attending in Bible Study. I am just praying that my plea bargaining will be approved this month so that I can go home and be with my kids again. Thank you and God bless.
